

# Student Equipment List

If in doubt it is better to over-pack rather than under-pack. Old clothes are ideal. A complete change of clothing is recommended for each day, since students will be outdoors and active. Great Basin temperatures can vary from hot days to very cold nights. If you don't have and can't get some of the gear, please let your child's teacher know, as Great Basin Outdoor School has a limited quantity of some items to lend.

**Please mark all items with your child's name. On the first day please come to school with equipment packed in a small, easily carried bag and lunch in a separate bag.**
